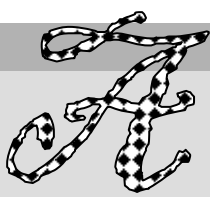

In Class:

We are currently building 3-dimensional shoes from butcher paper and paper bags. **The due date for this project is March 7th.**

We have completed exploring the terminology for the decorative Art Journal. Now students have the responsibility of applying the information that they have learned and create an Art Journal that displays the information that was gathered from the questions within the Art Journal packet. The Art Journal is a homework assignment. Students were given this assignment on the first day of this semester. Students were given 4 weeks to explore the terminology and 3.5 weeks to build and decorate the Scrapbook style Art Journal. Student can build the cover in class. I have given demonstrations and assisted those students that are having trouble coming up with ideas and making the cover to their Journals.
