Follow these simple steps to participate in the Superintendent's Reading Honor Roll:

- Ask your teacher or media specialist how many books are required for your grade level.
- Ask a parent to read this brochure and approve your participation in the program.
- Visit your school or public library and select the first book you want to read. If you need help selecting a book, ask your school media specialist.
- Read the book and talk about it with your friends, parents, and teachers.
- Put the book title and author on the reading log and have a parent or teacher sign the log to verify that you have read the book.
- After finishing one book, select the next and follow the same steps outlined above.
- After you have read your required number of books, turn in your completed reading log to your school's media specialist.
- Your reading log must be turned in no later than May 1, 2012.
- Your Superintendent's Reading Honor Roll certificates will be sent to you in May.

I hope you choose to complete this challenge. I want to share the value and power of good books. Reading lasts a lifetime.
