Attendance At-a-Glance

In a <u>YEAR-LONG</u> class, a student is allowed 10 (ten) unexcused Absences

In a <u>SEMESTER</u> class, a student is allowed 5 (five) unexcused absences.

In a **QUARTER** class, a student is allowed 3 (three) unexcused absences.

*A student is considered truant when you have 3 consecutive unexcused absences or a total of 5 unexcused absences
