Academic Opportunities

Myrtle Beach High School offers a wide array of rigorous academic opportunities for our students. MBHS provides highly motivated students with 20-course options in the Advanced Placement Program. Additionally, our AP Seahawks have the ability to earn the prestigious Advanced Placement International Diploma or the AP Capstone Diploma. The International Diploma is a credential that allows students to demonstrate outstanding academic achievement on AP exams across several disciplines. The AP Capstone Program is the College Board's highest honor bestowed to students, and also the most rigorous. Exploring interdisciplinary studies with a concentration on global conflict, students are tasked with analyzing contending perspectives, developing original arguments, and producing original research that is held to the strict professional standards of professional academic journals. Our Career and Technology Education program offers students six different completer tracks including: Health Science, Sports Medicine, General Management, Finance, Hospitality and Tourism, and Web and Digital Communication. Myrtle Beach High School also offers opportunities in Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Engineering and Computer Science Courses, Dual Enrollment Opportunities through a partnership with Horry-Georgetown Technical College (HGTC), Teacher Cadet through a partnership with Coastal Carolina University (CCU), an award-winning NJROTC Program, Marching and Concert Band, Orchestra, Show Choir, Performing and Technical Theater, World Language, a variety of immersive courses in the Fine Arts, and a plethora of CP and Honors Level Courses to meet the needs of our beautifully diverse student body.

ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS & RECOGNITIONS

Myrtle Beach High School had four National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists and one National Merit Commended Scholar for the 2021 year! Our Advanced Placement percentage passing rate surpassed that of South Carolina and the global average. The Seahawks are identified in the fine arts with the honor of having a Distinguished Arts Program. The Navy JROTC program was recognized as a Distinguished Unit for the 2020-2021 school year; this is the 6th consecutive year we have been recognized with this honor. The drill team finished 2nd in Area Six (North & South Carolina) and qualified and participated in the National Navy JROTC drill competition.
