

Frequently Asked Questions

- Who can schedule a Child Find appointment?

Parents or legal guardians can schedule a Child Find Appointment. Grandparents, doctors, teachers, or anyone concerned about a child's development can share Child Find information with parents. Parents must give written permission for screenings.

- How do I schedule a Child Find appointment?

Call the Preschool Assessment Office at [843-488- 6220](tel:843-488-6220) to schedule an appointment.

- Who will screen my child?

The Child Find team consists of a school psychologist, a speech/language pathologist, and related service providers, as needed.

- When will I know the results?

Following the completion of the screening, the team will review the screening results with you and make recommendations.

WHAT?

What is Child Find?

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) which requires states to identify, locate, and evaluate all children with disabilities between the ages of 3 and 21, who are in need of early intervention or educational services.

Horry County Schools Preschool Assessment Office provides free developmental screenings throughout the year for children between the ages of 3 and 5 through the Child Find screening process.

A multidisciplinary team will meet with you and your child to conduct a screening in the areas of:

Hearing and Vision/Developmental Skills/ Communication Skills

Following the screening process, the team will review the results with you and will provide recommendations. Our team will schedule follow-up appointments (observations and/or evaluations) based on the child's individual needs, as appropriate.

HOW?

1. Call the CHILD Find office to schedule an appointment:

2. Attend the CHILD Find screening with your child & participate in the evaluation planning conference, as appropriate.

3. Attend scheduled evaluation appointments with your child.

4. Participate as a member of the team to review evaluation results; discuss educational needs; and develop a plan to meet those needs, if appropriate.
