- *Applicants must meet the requirements to be eligible for state and national certification exams.*
- *Applicants for the Advanced Art Major may be required to submit a portfolio of work for evaluation prior to admission to the program.*
- *There will be a waiting list prior to the first day of the upcoming school year.*

Step 2: Barbering major applicants must agree to complete a required one-day summer training program for a student barber permit to be held in Columbia, SC.

Step 3: Applicants who meet the requirements in Steps 1 and 2 will be eligible for scoring as outlined below.
