Academic Opportunities

Aynor High School hosts one of Horry County Schools' two International Baccalaureate (IB) programs. The general objectives of the IB program are to provide students with a balanced education, to facilitate geographic and cultural mobility, and to promote international understanding through academic experience. The IB diploma is designed for students in their last two years of high school.

Students may earn a SC high school diploma while working to meet the requirements for the IB diploma.

The IB Diploma Program is a challenging and rigorous curriculum leading to a qualification widely recognized by leading universities in the United States and worldwide. All highly motivated and high-performing students who completed the advanced recommended courses are given the opportunity to participate in the IB Diploma Program.

In addition to IB course offerings, Aynor High also offers the following Advanced Placement (AP) courses: AP Language and Composition, AP Literature and Composition, AP US History, AP Human Geography, AP Environmental Science, AP Art - Drawing, and AP Art - Studio 2D Design. Aynor High School offers distinct Career and Technology Education (CTE) majors,



including Human Services/Family and Consumer Sciences, Marketing, General Management, Game and Interactive Media Design, Environmental and Natural Resources Management, and Agriculture Mechanics and Technology. We also offer Project Lead the Way courses in Computer Science and Biomedical Science.





ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Students must complete an online IB application to be considered for admittance. Students are eligible to apply while in grades 8-10. Students who are accepted into the IB program and who live outside of the Aynor attendance area may apply to attend AHS by requesting a waiver through the HCS Office of Student Affairs.
