Academic Opportunities

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

Aynor High School hosts one of Horry County Schools two International Baccalaureate (IB) programs. The general objectives of the IB program are to provide students with a balanced education; to facilitate geographic and cultural mobility; and to promote international understanding through academic experience. The IB diploma is designed for students in their last two years of high school. Students have the opportunity to earn a SC high school diploma while working to meet the requirements for the IB diploma. The IB Diploma Program is a challenging and rigorous curriculum leading to a qualification that is widely recognized by leading universities in the United States and around the world.

All highly motivated and high-performing students who completed the advanced recommended courses, are given the opportunity to participate in the IB Diploma Program.



ADVANCED PLACEMENT

In addition to IB course offerings, Aynor also offers a number of Advanced Placement (AP) courses; which include: AP Language and Composition, AP Literature and Composition, AP US History, AP Calculus, AP Human Geography, AP Environmental Science, and AP Art.

CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION

Aynor High School offers three distinct CATE majors including Family and Consumer Sciences, Business and Information Technology, and Environmental Natural Resources.



IB ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete an online IB application to be considered for admittance. Students are eligible to apply while in grades 8-10. Students who are accepted into the IB program must complete the HCS transfer waiver (online) form and transfer to AHS.

Because students who are accepted into the IB program must transfer to Aynor High School, HCS does not provide transportation for students living outside the Aynor attendance area.
