Academic Opportunities

Loris High School is a comprehensive high school that prepares students for life in the 21st century. Our goal is to ensure that all students are prepared for college and career. We also strive to make sure that all students possess the world class skills, knowledge and life and career characteristics needed to be a successful contributor to society. At Loris High, students are enrolled in college preparatory, honors, or Advanced Placement courses that are academically challenging and technology rich. We are proud to announce that we offer 8 Advanced Placement courses: AP Calculus, AP Statistics, AP Human Geography, AP US History, AP Government, AP Environmental Science, AP English Language and AP English Literature.

Students may also decide to take college courses offered through a collaboration with Horry Georgetown Technical College or participate in Teacher Cadet, which is offered through a partnership between Coastal Carolina University and the South Carolina Center for Educator Recruitment, Retention, and advancement (CERRA). In addition to having rigorous academic standards in English, math, social studies, and science, we also offer courses in World Languages, Fine Arts, and career and technology education (CATE). Students who participate in our CATE courses have the opportunity to earn CATE Completer recognition in Agriculture Science/ Horticulture, Health Science, Marketing, and Operations Management.

Students also have the opportunity to participate in the Medial Magnet program, which is offered through a partnership with Loris McLeod Hospital and Horry Georgetown Technical College. Our most recent addition is the PLTW program that empowers students to build knowledge and skills in biomedical science, as well as in-demand, transportable skills like problem solving, critical and creative thinking, communication, and collaboration. Loris High School prides itself on preparing students for the 21st century, and we are proud of the partnerships we have formed with our local businesses and community members to ensure that all of our students are successful.
