Academic Accomplishments

North Myrtle Beach High School provides a safe, nurturing, and academically competitive learning environment that is innovative and student-centered. This environment is provided through the implementation of our school's vision: to be recognized as one of the premier schools in one of the nation's premier school systems, in which every student receives an excellent education. North Myrtle Beach High School demonstrates this vision by offering a variety of opportunities in both academics and extracurricular activities for students to take advantage of to broaden experiences and foster talents. In addition to core academic courses, students have opportunities to study in the areas of business, culinary arts, dual-enrollment courses through Horry Georgetown Technical College, Advanced Placement Courses, STEM courses, visual arts, performing arts, band, orchestra, Spanish, and Naval Junior ROTC. Extracurricular opportunities such as drama, robotics, book club, band, orchestra, student council, Beta Club, National Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, English Honor Society, Social Studies Honor Society, Science Honor Society, nternational Thespian Society, Spanish Honor Society, ROTC, Christmas Angels, and athletics give students opportunities to engage in community service opportunities while building experiences.

For the 2022-2023 school year, the school's CTE offerings were expanded, adding a Cybersecurity course to the Project Lead the Way courses, which already included Intro to Engineering Design, Computer Science Principles, Civil Engineering and Architecture, and Principles of Biomedical Sciences. The student body has brought many accomplishments and honors to NMBHS. The Class of 2023 generated over \$11.3 million in scholarships. Our AP test pass rates remain at or above state and global percentages.

Academic Opportunities

North Myrtle Beach High School offers dual-enrollment courses as part of its Program for Accelerated College Enrollment (PACE) through Horry-Georgetown Technical College (HGTC), as well as



Career and Technology Education (CTE) cluster courses (Culinary, Business, and Health Services) and Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) courses. NMBHS also offers Advanced Placement courses in Biology, Calculus AB, European History, Government, Human Geography, Literature, Language, Statistics, and U.S. History.
