Academic Opportunities

Socastee High School joins a worldwide community of more than 5,000 schools in 150 countries that offer the rigorous International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IB), which provides highly motivated students with a wide variety of course offerings! To participate, students must complete prerequisite courses in grades 9 and 10. These advanced and motivated students will have the opportunity to earn the International Baccalaureate Diploma, an internationally recognized standard of academic excellence. The International Baccalaureate Organization, a leader in international education, provides IB students with a regularly updated, forward-thinking curriculum; it also recognizes that IB students are gifted learners who can develop more completely as compassionate students and as individuals who will assume a role in contributing to our shared humanity as well as guardianship of our planet. Some benefits of the program include a traditional high school setting, criteria for admission to international universities, travel possibilities, IB scholarships offered by various colleges, and up to two years of college credit. Socastee High School International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offers English Literature HL, French B SL, Spanish B SL, History of the Americas HL, 20th Century Topics HL, Information Technology for a Global Society HL & SL, Psychology SL, Biology HL, Chemistry SL, Physics SL, Applications and Interpretations of Mathematics SL, Visual Arts SL & HL, and Theory of Knowledge. Socastee High School's IB Diploma program has earned some important distinctions: our diploma success rate is above the international average (292 IB Diplomas awarded since 2000), we are a recognized leader in international education, our diploma recipients have attended more than 70 different colleges and universities worldwide, and millions of dollars in scholarships have been offered to past IB classes.

Socastee High also offers Career and Technology Education (CTE) courses in Agriculture, Building Construction, Health Occupations, Information Technology, Food & Nutrition, and Marketing. We offer College Preparatory, Honors, and Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Our AP courses include AB and BC Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, English Language, English Literature, European History, US Government and Politics, Human Geography, US History, Physics, and Psychology. We also offer dual-enrollment courses with Horry-Georgetown Technical College through our Project for Accelerated College Enrollment (PACE), as well as Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) - Principles of Biomedical Science and Principles of Engineering. We have courses to support special needs students through secure and self-contained settings.



Entrance Requirements

Socastee attendance area students who have successfully completed middle school are eligible to attend Socastee High School. All Horry County students interested in participating in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in Grades 11 and 12 must complete prerequisite courses and apply for the IB program.
