SHS boasts 14 IB courses of which nine are dual enrollment AP/IB. The Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered in Biology, Calculus (AB & BC), English Language, English Literature, Psychology, US History, European History, Human Geography, Government, Statistics, Physics, and Chemistry.

In addition to a rigorous AP and IB program, SHS offers many Career and Technical Education opportunities, such as Marketing, Health Science, Fashion Merchandising, Gaming and Animation, Google Applications, Web Design, Building Construction, and Horticulture.

Socastee High School hosts one of Horry County Schools two International Baccalaureate (IB) programs. The general objectives of the IB program are to provide students with a balanced education; to facilitate geographic and cultural mobility; and to promote international

Entrance Requirements

Students who do not live in the Socastee attendance area must complete an online IB application to be considered for admittance to either the SHS pre-IB or the IB. Students are eligible to apply while in grades 8 – 10. Students who are accepted into the IB program who do not live in the Socastee attendance area must complete the HCS transfer waiver online form by June 30th and transfer to SHS.

Additional Information

Because students who are accepted into the IB program must transfer to SHS, HCS does not provide transportation for students living outside of the SHS attendance area.
