Senior Information 2022-2023

- SENIOR SUPPLY DELIVERY - May 2nd
 - Senior Supply orders placed and paid for earlier in the school year will be available for pick-up on May 2nd during lunches or after school (3:30-4:30).
 - Lowcountry Grad will not accept any orders after 04/30/2023 for caps and gowns. Any order placed from today up until the 20th would be delivered to the student's home, not Myrtle Beach High School.
- SENIOR DEVICE COLLECTION - May 19th. Starting 1st block in the Library Learning Commons until finished.
 - Have the computers charged the night before and turned on when turning them in.
 - NOTE: After all computers and chargers are scanned into the system, Mr. Spiegel will run a missing computer/charger report and then inform TNT of these missing devices. TNT then assigns the Technology fines.
 - Missing computers are \$635 fine, missing chargers are a \$38 fine. All computers and chargers were assigned to students according to the barcode on the device.
 - Turning in a charger with a missing/purposely damaged barcode or turning in someone else's charger will not help the student.

- GRADUATION SIGN-OFF SHEET - May 24th (Deadline for Completion)
 - May 22
 - We will host an early sign-off session from 3:30-4:30 in the auditorium for students who would like to go ahead and get their forms completed
 - Following final exams on May 24th, if you have not had your Sign-Off sheet completed yet, please report to the auditorium. At the beginning of 3rd block, all of the necessary staff members for signatures will be stationed in the auditorium to clear each section.
 - *Students will not be permitted to walk the building at any other times to collect signatures from the required faculty/staff*
 - Must be completed and turned in to Mrs. Byrdic

- ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT CLEARED ALL FEES AND FINES BEFORE 8:30 AM on June 2nd will not be permitted to practice until all fees and fines are cleared. Any student not ready to practice at 8:30 AM will be moved to the back of the line.

- AWARDS NIGHT – May 24th at 6:00 PM
 - Attire is dressy -no jeans, shorts, tennis shoes or flip-flops.
 - Ceremony is invitation only based on recipients of awards.

- SENIOR WALK – May 26th at 8:30 AM
 - Must have cap and gown. Gown must remain zipped and worn properly throughout the entire walk
 - Arrive at 8:30 in the auditorium at MBHS
 - Walk will depart campus promptly at 9:00 am

- GRADUATION PRACTICE
 - June 2nd at 8:30 AM
 - We will begin practice in the auditorium. In order to practice, your Graduation Sign-Off sheet must have been turned in and cleared.
 - You must attend the entire practice, or you will not be able to participate in the ceremony. Tickets to the ceremony are distributed at the conclusion of practice.

- COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY – June 2nd, 7:00 PM
 - The gates to Doug Shaw Memorial Stadium will open at 5:30 PM for parents to enter through Gates 1 and 2. There will be a clear bag policy in effect and all guests will enter through the standard search process.
 - Graduates must meet in the MBHS lobby at 5:30 sharp. Graduates will be seated in alphabetical order in the auditorium. Administration will then line the graduates up to process to Doug Shaw Memorial Stadium. You must be in your assigned place in line by 6:00 PM for roll call. Anyone not in his/her assigned place by 6:00 PM will be placed at the back of the line, out of ABC order.
 - Graduates will be allotted ten (10) total tickets which graduates will receive at the end of practice on the morning of June 2nd.
 - All guests will be seated in the stands on a first come first served basis; seats are not assigned.

- DRESS FOR GRADUATION
 - Boys – white dress shirt, dark tie, navy blue or black pants, dark dress shoes and dark socks. NO flip-flops, Sperry like shoes, or tennis shoes.
 - Girls – If the hemline of your garment is longer than the graduation robe it must be white or black. Shoes must be black, clear, or nude/tan. No flip-flops or stiletto heels (due to the surface of the track).
 - If you need assistance with attire, please let your school counselor or Mrs. Altman know.
 - Graduates who do not meet the dress code requirements will not be permitted to march in the ceremony.

- Only nationally recognized honor society cords and stoles may be worn during the graduation ceremony; regalia will be checked by faculty on site.
- Graduation caps may not be painted or decorated.
