



All 11th grade students (third year of high school) are being offered the opportunity to take the ACT or the SAT at their high school during the regular school week at no cost. The State Department of Education (SCDE) will be paying for one assessment per student. However, students must sign up in advance in order to take one of these tests. The ACT will be given at their school on Tuesday, February 23, 2021, and the SAT will be given Wednesday March 3, 2021.
