Welcome Back Juniors


Juniors and Parents,

Junior Class Ring Orders and Date

PSAT Dates

All 11th grade students enrolled in an honors, AP, or IB English or Math class will be scheduled to take the PSAT on Wednesday, October 16 at no cost. Any other Juniors who would like to take the PSAT may do so by signing up in guidance by September 24. The sign up sheet is on the first table as you enter the guid-

ance office. Cost for the Juniors to take the PSAT is \$17 if you are not enrolled in an honors, AP, or IB English or Math class this year.

There will be a pre-administration session for all students signed up for the PSAT on Thursday, September 26 during second block. Please make every effort to attend this important session.

The PSAT will be administered on Wednesday, October 16. There is no make-up session for PSAT so students must be in school on time that day to take the exam. Please let me know if you have questions about PSAT.

National Honor Society

National Honor Society is now accepting applications for new members from this year's junior and senior class. The basic requirements for membership are

- An excellent academic record with a minimum 3.8 weighted GPA
- At least two honors or higher level classes each year since 9th grade
- A high level of school and community involvement
- Outstanding character
 If you believe you might qualify, see Ms. Gaddy or Mrs. Keller in Guidance for an application. All completed paperwork is due no later than Friday, September 27. Late applications will NOT be accepted for any reason.

Students who are selected to become a member of National Honor Society will be required to do community service hours. Students must also maintain their weighted GPA and character requirements. Students should not have any discipline infractions. Please pick up your applications this week.
