



What is the lollipop line?

- The lollipop line is a way for staff to **reward positive student behavior**.
- The lollipop line is independent of the Phoenix Program and any other school-wide or classroom incentives such as a classroom treasure box, field trips, etc.



How does the lollipop line work?

- When a staff member observes a student going **above and beyond**, the staff member can call Ms. Anderson in the front office.
- The staff member explains what the student did and requests the lollipop line.
- Ms. Anderson reports to the classroom. She will reiterate/reinforce what the student did to earn a lollipop and allow the student to pick out a lollipop.



The Daily Double

- Each week, there will be a **specific skill or attribute that will be the focus of the daily group counseling sessions.**
- Students that go above and beyond demonstrating the **specific skill or attribute of the week** are eligible to receive **two lollipops** from the lollipop line instead of just one lollipop.
- The same procedure of staff contacting Ms. Anderson will be followed. The difference is the student behavior will be reported as the daily double and the student will be able to select **two lollipops.**
