### The PACE/Dual Enrollment Application Process

1. Obtain a PACE Dual Enrollment Application Packet from your Guidance Counselor.

2. Access Pace Online Application at [www.hgtc.edu/pace/apply](http://www.hgtc.edu/pace/apply).  
*\*Do NOT navigate away from this page until you create an account.*
3. Create an Account. Be sure to save your Username and Password.
4. Login to your HGTC Account to complete the PACE Online Application. It is recommended to have your parent/guardian present when you complete your application due to the information required. It is important you complete all information especially residency questions to ensure quick processing of your application.
5. Once you have submitted your online application, please submit your **test scores** and the remainder of this packet to your Guidance Counselor for approval and course selections (see course info below).

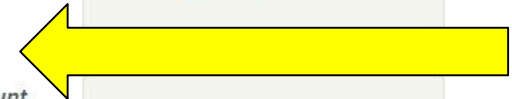

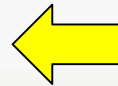


