To participate in the **2022 Daisy Elementary School Summer Reading Adventure:**

- ❑ Rising **1st & 2nd** graders will complete a Reading Adventure Map that includes 20 fun 15-minute reading activities (parents may help students with reading & writing if needed)
- ❑ Rising **3rd, 4th, & 5th** graders will complete a Reading Adventure Map that includes 25 fun 20-minute reading activities

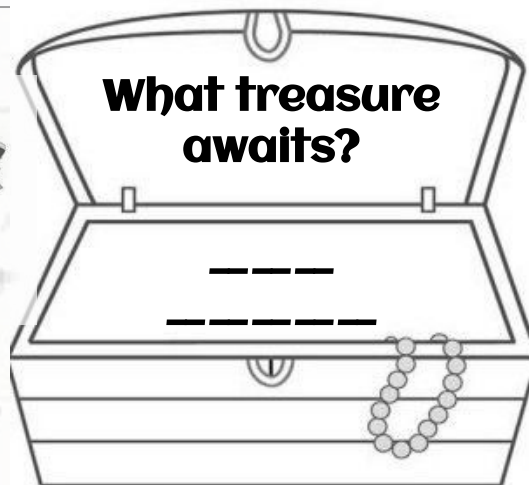

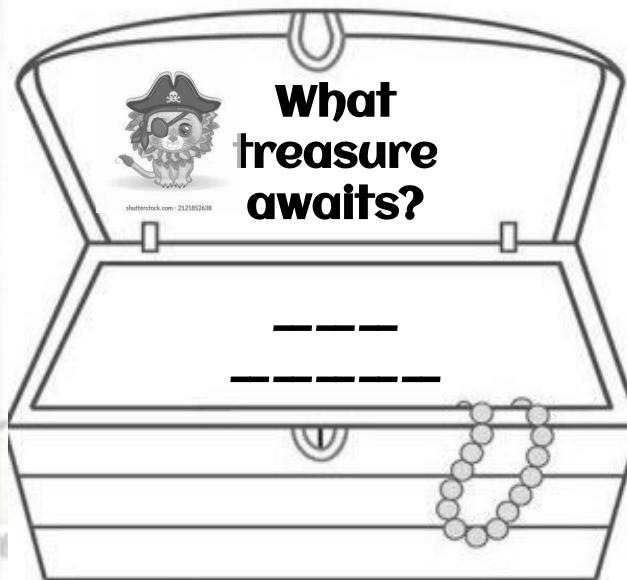
