- Social and ethical implications of medical genetics

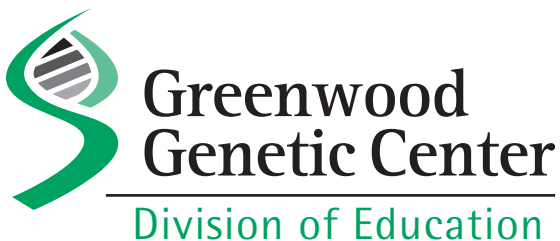


GRAND STRAND CAMP*
