- 3. The applicant must plan to pursue a career in education.
- 4. The applicant must have maintained a good high school academic record and maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point ratio while attending college.
- 5. The applicant must demonstrate leadership abilities.
- 6. The applicant must need financial assistance.

The scholarship recipient will be notified on or before May 15 and the scholarship money would be sent to the college they plan to attend by August 1.
