WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

The SIS Inspirations Merit Scholarship is open to young female high school seniors that attends school in the Horry County School District. They must have at least a 2.5 GPA and plans to attend college or trade school in the Fall.

2021-2022 ESSAY TOPIC

Life sometimes put obstacles in our way that we may not expect but must deal with. When faced with these obstacles, we have two choices - either stop moving forward or figure out a way to deal with, move, or work around the obstacles. The essay should describe some obstacles you may have come up against, and how you chose to overcome them.

ESSAY RULES

- Essay must be the applicants own work
- Applicants may only submit ONE essay and apply only ONE time
- Essay must be a minimum of 500 words
- Students who do not follow the guidelines will be disqualified
