








Distance Learning Information

- Group A will complete distance learning activities on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays of each week during the Hybrid or Distance Learning Modules. Activities are due and should be submitted before returning to school the following Monday.
- Your child will log onto their Seesaw Class App on their school iPad. They must complete the listed activities for their Distance Learning Days 1, 2, and 3 for each week.
- To log onto their Seesaw Class App
 - Click on the Clever App 
 - Scan the QR code in their folder 
 - Scroll down to the Seesaw App in Clever 
 - Click the 'To Do' folder 
 - Click on '+ Add Response' for the Weekly Distance Learning Activity for that week.
 - Listen to the directions to complete and submit the activities.

Some activities will have them use the Lexia App. To access Lexia, your child will:

- Click on the Lexia App (if they are already logged into Clever; it will automatically log them in.) 
- if they are not logged in, they will click on the C- Log in with Clever button at the bottom 
- Scan your QR code in your folder to log in. 
- Please make sure that your child ONLY does 10 minutes per distance learning day on Lexia unless otherwise directed from the teacher.

(Optional) Distance Learning Activities

If your child completes their required Distance Learning Activities for the week, these are some other optional resources that they may use.

- **Epic** 

To log in, tap "Enter Class Code" and enter skc7845. Then, pick their name and read or listen to the books in their mailbox.

- **Everyday Math Games Online** 

To log into Clever with their QR code, then click on the McGraw Hill App. Next, click Everyday Mathematics 4 Grade K. Then, click EM Games Online.

- **Freckle** 

To log into Clever with their QR code, then click on the Freckle App to play math games.

- **Practice word wall words**

Practice our word wall words for the week and review any previous words. Please see the back of the word list for fun ideas!

- **Starfall** 

They can click on the Starfall App on their iPads or use a computer to access the full version on Starfall.com.

- **ABC Tracing App** 

The ABC tracing App on their iPads is fun and beneficial.

- **Read Aloud**

Read to your child or have them read their books independently. Discuss the setting, characters, and have them retell the story. They can illustrate their favorite part and hunt for word wall words in the book.
