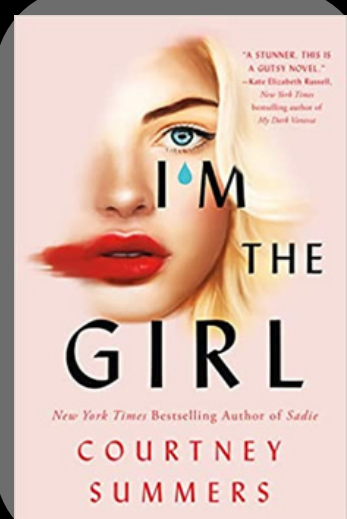

Clean Energy Students @ Coastal Carolina

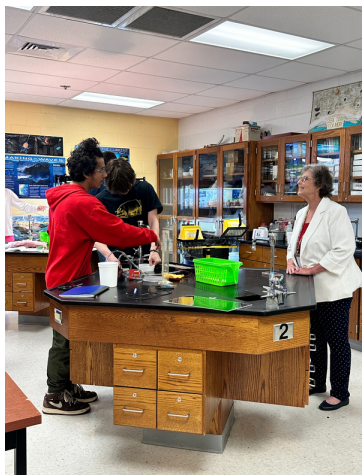
