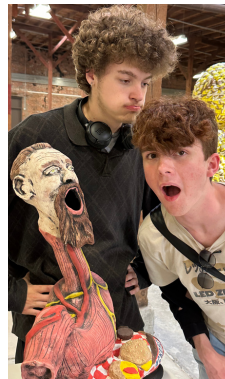

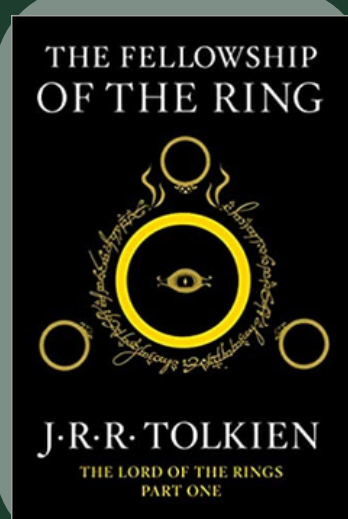
The League of Women Voters of Horry County was at AAST during lunch periods today to register our students to vote for the 2024 Elections.
