Athletic News

Please be advised that the Arbiter Athlete system is transitioning BACK to the name PlanetHS. Although the name has changed, the system will look the same and athletes and parents will use the same log in credentials to access their account on www.planeths.com. Please, do not create a new account!

Students who are interested in trying out for a spot on the 2019-20 Seahawk athletic teams can complete their PlanetHS accounts now for the upcoming year. All physicals must be dated after April 1, 2019. A new completed account will be valid for all 3 seasons next school year. As in previous years, the Seahawk athletic department will still be offering student athlete pass for those with completed accounts (including all forms uploaded and approved). However, this year the cost will be on a sliding scale based on completion of the account:

Completed Account Date	Cost
April 1, 2019 – May 31, 2019	FREE!
June 1, 2019 – June 30, 2019	\$10
July 1, 2019 – July 31, 2019	\$20
August 1, 2019 – August 31, 2019	\$30
September 1, 2019 and after	\$40

New physical forms can be picked up in the main office at Myrtle Beach High School, Myrtle Beach Middle School or download the attached physical packet. Forms have also been dropped off at local doctor's offices for your convenience.
