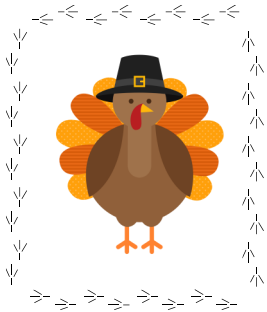

Parents,

With our federal nutrition guidelines, there are serious limitations to what will be allowed. Please pay careful attention to the information below and follow the guidelines appropriately.

1. Treat bags that contain food items will not be allowed. If they are sent, we will have to return them to you.
2. Cupcakes, cakes or candy will not be allowed due to the federal nutrition guidelines.
3. All food items served must meet the federal guidelines for nutrition. Please work with your child's teacher on party foods and only send what is requested from the teacher.
4. No food items may be served to the class in the cafeteria and classes may not skip the school lunch program to have a party.
5. Horry County Schools has developed a list of items that do meet the federal guidelines. Below you will find several examples.

-Multigrain Fruit Bars, Granola Bars, Ginger Snips, Cracker/Pretzel Mixes, Animal-shaped Cookies, Bear-shaped Graham Crackers, Graham Cracker Sticks

-Trail/Yogurt Mixes, Dried Fruit, Raisins, Cranberries, Figs, etc, Sunflower Seeds (without shells), Almonds

-Apples, Oranges, Bananas, Melons (Cantaloupe, Watermelon, etc.), Pears, Peaches, Grapes

-Celery Sticks, Baby Carrots, Sliced Colored Bell Peppers, Broccoli Florets

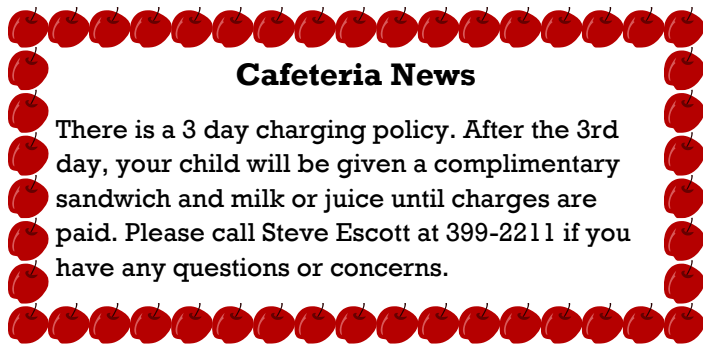
