#### Security Procedures

You must bring in a driver's license or identification each time you pick up a child or visit our school.

Instruction begins at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 2:35 p.m. Please make sure your child arrives in time for class and does not leave early. Adult supervision begins at 7:00 a.m. Students should arrive at school no earlier than 7:00 a.m. As a reminder, the morning car rider gate will close at 7:30 am each day. If you are already in the line, your child will not receive a tardy pass. However, if you come through the front entrance, before 7:30 OR after the gate is closed, your child is tardy and will receive a tardy pass. School starts at 7:30 am, so you cannot wait until that time to enter the lot. You also cannot


