Does everyone have an Agenda, Aynor High School Softball Tryouts – 2022 form along with Aynor High School Softball – Handbook for Athletics and Coach, Player and Parent Contract?

The Softball Tryout Form should be completed and turned in before you leave tonight.

The Coach, Player and Parent Contract document must either be emailed to me or brought to tryouts – You will not be allowed to tryout until the document is signed by both parents/guardians and the player.

2. Varsity Softball Coaches – Tony Mills, Jimmy Todd, Ginny Roof and Neil Cox
3. Junior Varsity Softball Coaches – Chuck Page, Stevie Brown and Robert Hughes
4. All tryouts will be at the high school softball field - Varsity and Junior Varsity Tryouts will start on Monday, January 30th and end on Wednesday, February 1st – Be there no later than 4:30 pm and tryouts will start at 4:45 pm – we will finish around 7:00 pm
5. If you are currently playing a sport, you are not allowed to miss a game or practice to attend tryouts.
6. B Team Tryouts will start on Friday, February 3rd at 4:30 pm – be there no later than 4:15 pm – we will finish around 6:15 pm
7. B Team Tryouts will continue Saturday, February 4th at 10:30 am – Anyone wishing to try out for a team that couldn't come during the week should come to tryouts on Saturday.

8. Depending on how many pitchers and catchers we have, you may be asked to come to the field on Thursday to finish your tryout.
9. You are only required to come to one group of tryouts – for example if you come to the Varsity / Junior Varsity tryouts you are not required to come to the Friday or Saturday tryouts
- 10.If you tryout for the Varsity and do not make it, you will be considered for the Junior Varsity or B team.
- 11.Seniors can only be on the Varsity team – the B team is made up of only 7th and 8th graders – However, 7th and 8th graders can tryout for any of the three teams
- 12.We will not know if we will have a B team until all tryouts are over – we must also consider how many other teams in the county will have a B team
- 13.Bring all necessary equipment to tryouts, a water bottle and dress accordingly not knowing what the weather will be like.
- 14.Each night after tryouts, unless you drove to tryouts, you must wait at the softball field for your parent or guardian to be picked up.
- 15.If you are a new player, both the student and parent must setup an account on PlanetHS – visit www.PlanetHS.com and click on “sign up” or “log in.”
BOTH parents and student need to make separate accounts and then LINK the two accounts. See Coach Mills after the meeting for more information. For Middle School students, make sure when asked about your base school make you check Aynor High School and select softball so a head coach can see your account.
- 16.If you are a returning player with a PlanetHS account please make sure all documents including the physical are uploaded.
- 17.Bring all necessary equipment to tryouts with the exception of a batting helmet – you must wear a school approved helmet – catchers bring all catcher’s equipment and also bring something to drink such as water or Gatorade.
- 18.Please bring enough clothes so you can dress in layers.
- 19.Closed season is from January 26 through January 29 – Do not use the school facilities during this time.
