



Carolina Forest Advanced Placement Academy



Purpose: Our CFHS AP Academy allows students a choice in preparing for their academic future while providing them the flexibility to fully participate in a traditional high school experience.

Timeline: Students can apply to be in the Carolina Forest Advanced Placement Academy in the fall and spring semester every year they are enrolled at CFHS. All new applications must receive admittance from AP Board (based on qualifications).

CFHS Academy Advanced Placement: The goal of the Academy is to provide an opportunity for students to commit to a more rigorous academic program while developing involved college ready applicants.

12 th grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Successfully complete 11th grade requirements to continue without reapplication</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be enrolled in at least two AP classes or one AP class and two honors classes Meet disciplinary requirements as outlined by the board Participate in 10 hours of community service and in at least one school-sponsored organization Only one absence (excused or unexcused) allowed from mandatory meetings each semester

Students in good standing may utilize the following opportunities: college planning, principal excused academic lunch and early release, internships, an AP Academy study room/lounge, Jr/Sr Academy field trip, early scheduling of classes, and academic/real world lectures.

- AP Academy students will work towards an HCS Honors Diploma (additional requirements must be met).
- AP Academy students who complete an AP foreign language course will work towards an APID (additional requirements must be met).
- Applications will be reviewed prior to each semester and notification will be given via email for admission. Academy students will receive a probation/dismissal letter at the conclusion of each semester if they are in violation of program requirements.
