

Forestbrook Middle School The National Junior Beta Club By-Laws

- 1. The academic requirements for membership is a 3.5 average (AA or AB) with no grade lower than a "B' or an "S" on the 9-week report card. If a current member does not meet this requirement he/she will have a one-9 weeks probationary period to improve the grade. If he/she does not meet the requirement on the next 9-weeks report card, he/she will be dropped from membership. All Members must maintain a "B" average to stay in the Ir. Beta Club.
- 2. The disciplinary requirements will be no more than one Level 1 infraction per 9-weeks period. If the student exceeds 1 infraction, the student will be dropped from membership.
- 3. Members will be selected from Forestbrook Middle School Grades 6-8.
- 4. Forestbrook Middle School National Junior Beta Club Membership Annual dues are \$15.00.
- 5. The National Junior Beta Club officers will include the following: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member Representative.
- 6. A current member must complete 20 community service hours per year for membership.
- 7. The Forestbrook Middle School National Junior Beta Club will meet The first Wednesday of every month during the school year.
- 8. A member of the FMS Junior Beta Club may be dropped for the the following reasons:
 - Absences from 2 regular meetings.
 - Failure to meet academic or disciplinary guidelines.
 - Failure to meet the required 20 community hours per year.
